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Surveyor's Office recommending the Board adopt and authorize the Chair to sign Resolution **023-2023** for Abandonment of Easement 22-0004, to abandon a portion of a Drainage easement on Lot 45 of Stonebriar Unit No. 3, recorded in Book I of Subdivisions at Page 98, identified as Assessor's Parcel Number 117-200-006. Said property is within the community of El Dorado Hills, Supervisorial District 1, and is located at 3227 Montrose Way.

**FUNDING:** Application Fees (General Fund).

### **DISCUSSION / BACKGROUND**

A request has been submitted by Robert Joshua Lehr and Ashlyn Carol Lehr, husband and wife, as community property with right of survivorship, owners of Assessor's Parcel Number 117-200-006, requesting that the County of El Dorado, Board of Supervisors, vacate a portion of the rear Drainage easement located on said property. The portion of the easement to be abandoned is more particularly described in Exhibit A and depicted on Exhibit B of the attached Resolution.

The Drainage easement, as shown on Lot 45 of Stonebriar Unit No. 3, recorded in Book I of Subdivisions at Page 98, was offered to the County of El Dorado by Stonebriar, LP. A California Limited Partnership By: William Lyon Homes, Inc. A California Corporation Its General Partner, on February 20, 2001. The easement was acknowledged by the County of El Dorado on June 5, 2001, and the Subdivision Map was recorded on June 8, 2001.
