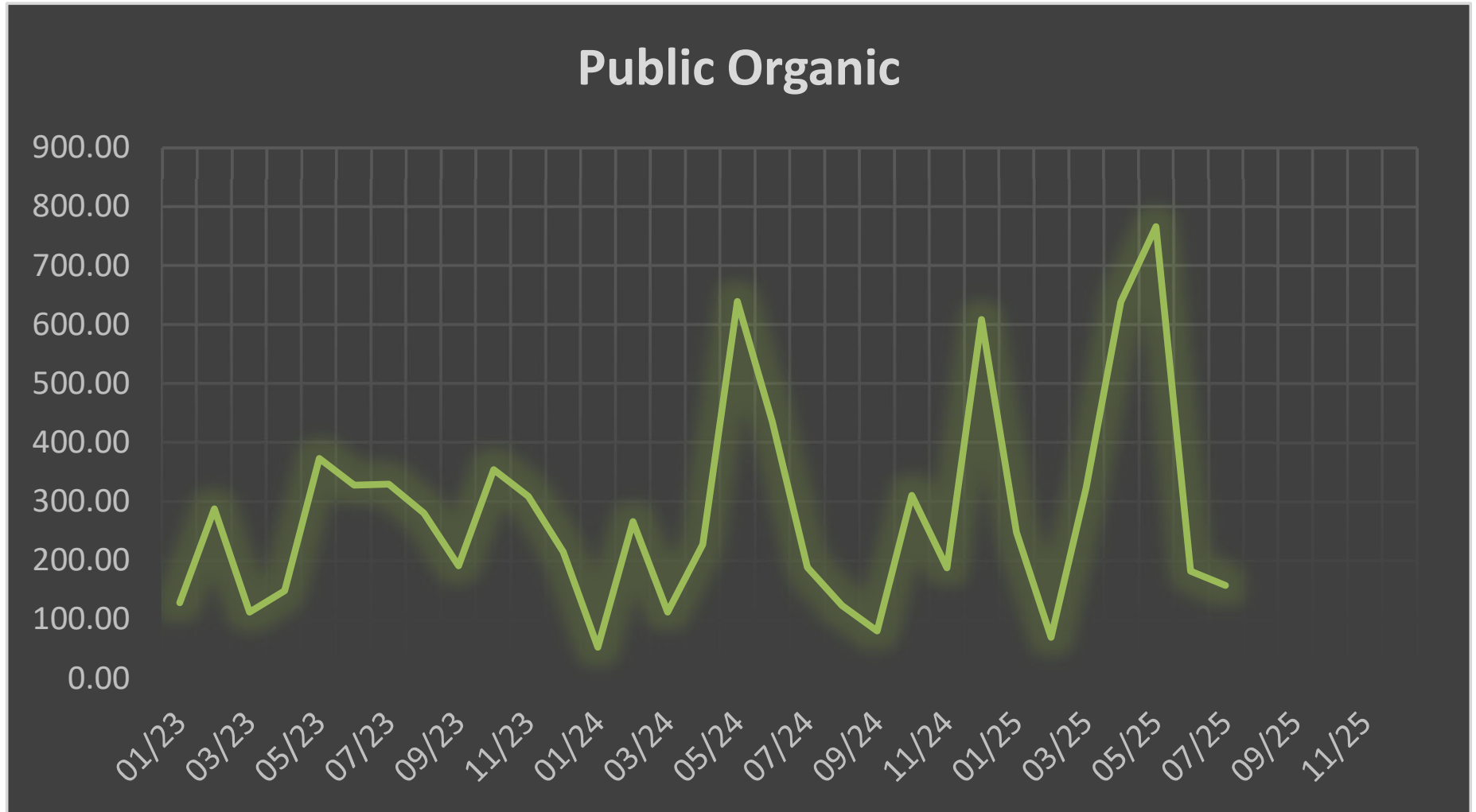


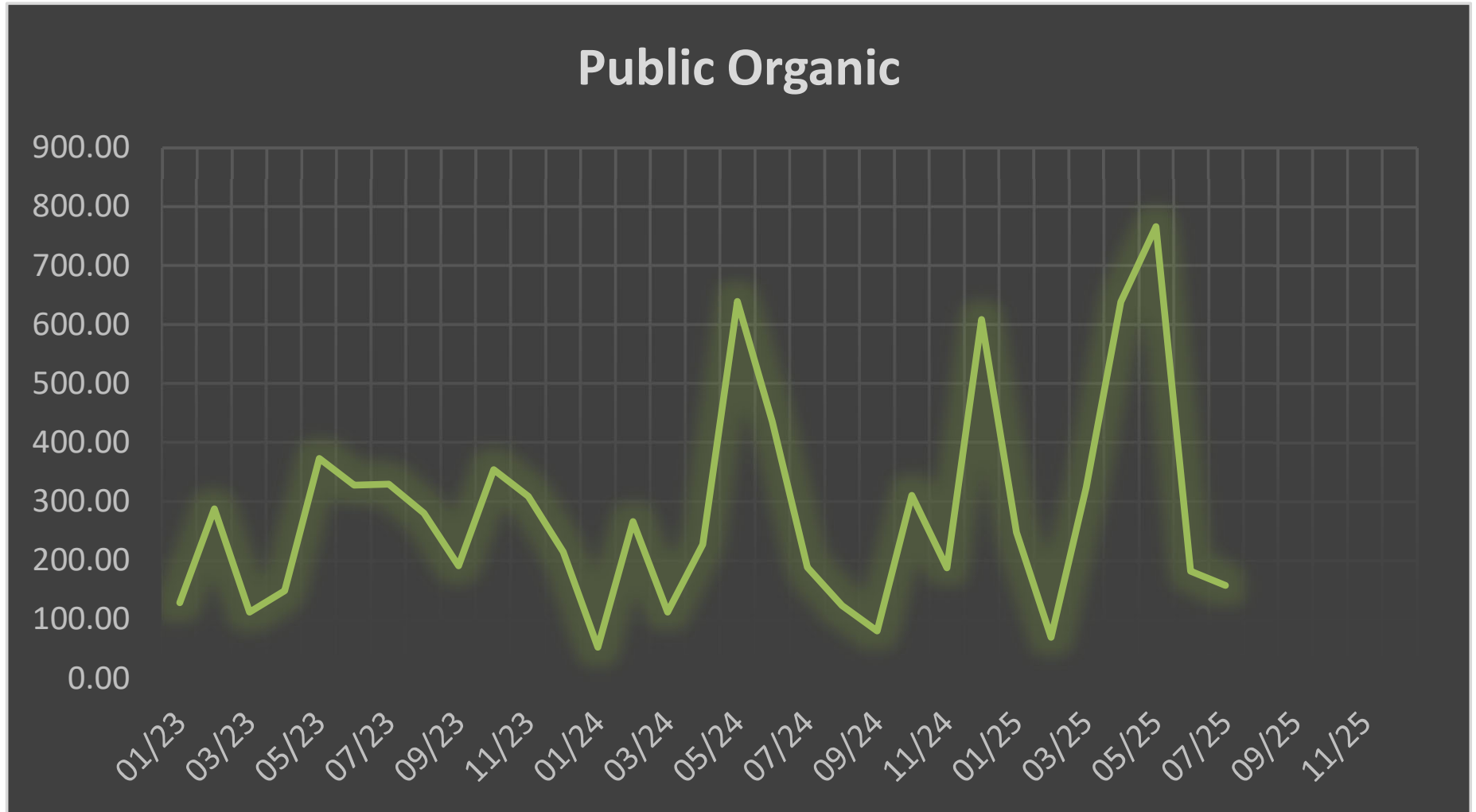




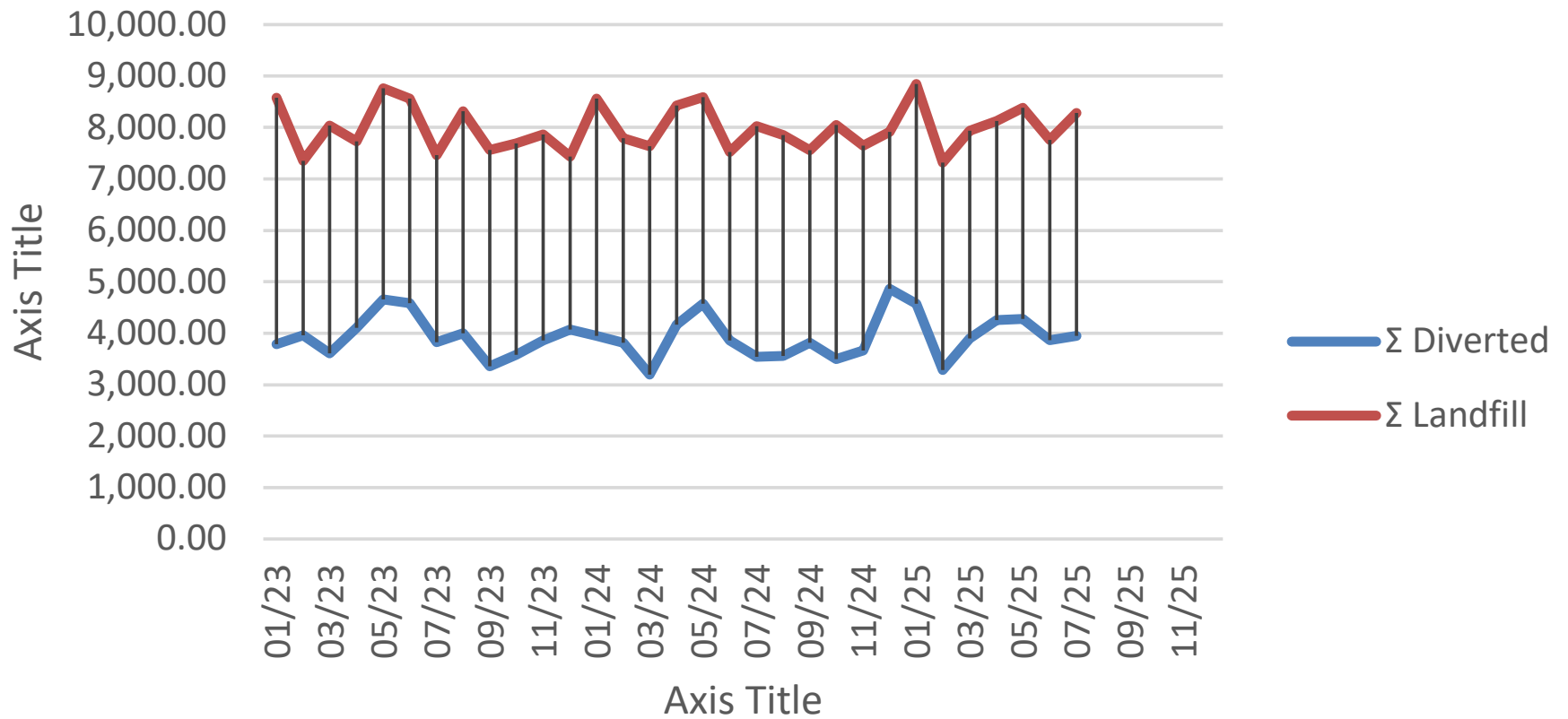








Total Landfill vs. Total Diverted
