

Ad Hoc Fish Stocking & Fish Purchase Policies

Background: Contacted six (6) county Fish & Wildlife Committees:
Alpine, Nevada, Placer, Calaveras, Butte, Yuba

Findings

- Fish Stocking of Private Ponds:
 - No county has a written policy, but all counties do NOT stock private ponds.
- Fish Purchase:
 - No county has a written policy.
 - One county in the past required requesting three (3) bids.

General Notes

- Most counties have formal partnerships for fish stocking to share costs.
- Need to develop or re-contact list for additional county F&W committees.
- Some counties may need written policies.

Alpine County

- Fish Stocking: No written policy. Do not stock private ponds.
 - Fish Purchase: No written policy. At times have requested three (3) bids.

- Stocking/Purchase: No written policy for stocking or purchasing. Do not stock private ponds.
